

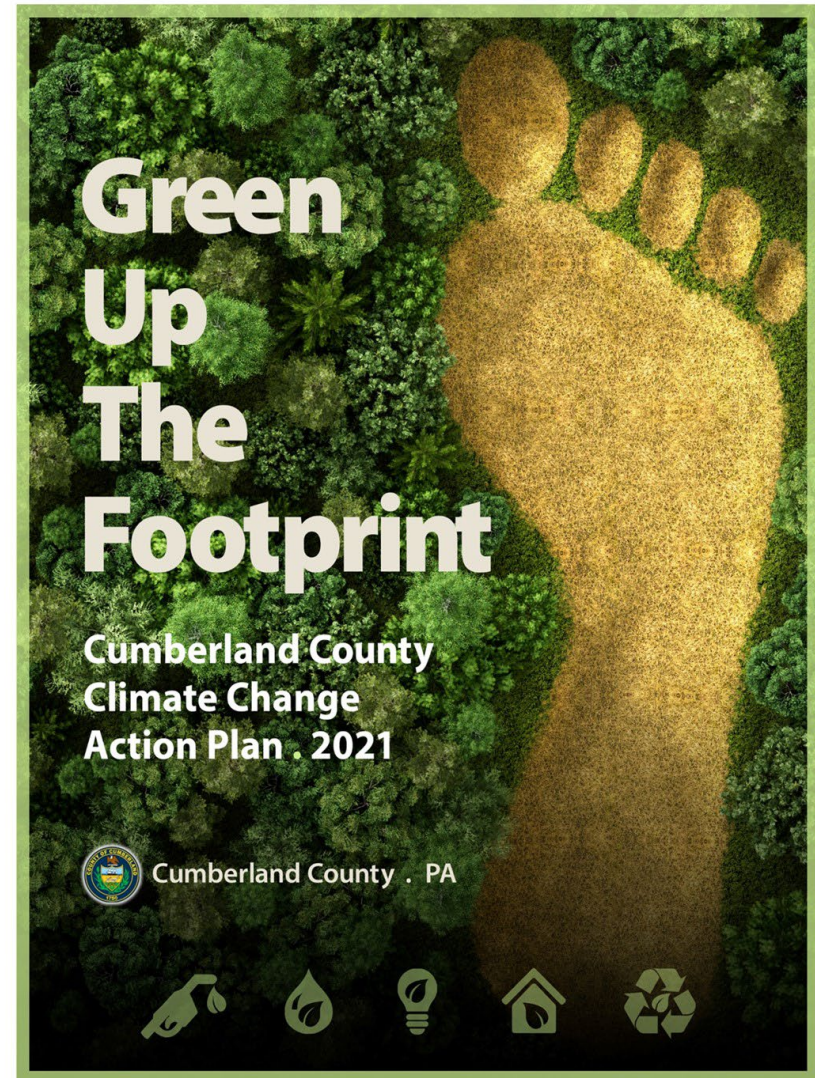

- PA DEP Local Climate Action Program 2020-2021 cohort
- Completed Greenhouse gas inventory
- Adopted Cumberland County Climate Action Plan January 2022



Climate Change

2021-2022 Shared Energy Manager Activities

- Solar on Warehouses Report
- Assessment of Solar on County Facilities
- DEP grant to begin electrification of county fleet



2020-2022 CAP Goal Achievement

Nitrogen Pound Reduction Goal	2022-2022 Nitrogen Reductions	Reduction Achieved
2,928,000	-591,455	20%

- Majority of reductions – better reporting of BMPs already on the ground
- CAP funded projects completed
 - Lawn conversion – 2.6 acres
 - Stream restoration – 1,300 linear feet
 - Dairy farm manure storage, culvert outlet, access road, tile drain & outlet

2023 CAP Funded Projects

- Conservation District Cover Crop Incentive Program
 - CAP goal: 36,900 acres each year
- NRCS rotational grazing: 7 projects
 - CAP goal: 500 acres managed
- Three stream restoration projects: 2,300 linear Feet
 - CAP goal: 7,900 linear feet urban stream restoration
- Anticipated reductions: 2,400 pounds of nitrogen!

American Recovery Plan Grants

- New Cumberland - \$350,000 for creation of riverfront park and stormwater enhancements
- Silver Spring Township - \$50,000 for design/engineering services for Paul Walters Park
- South Middleton Township - \$450,000 for Boiling Springs multi-modal project
- Upper Allen Township - \$450,000 for creation of new 60 acre park



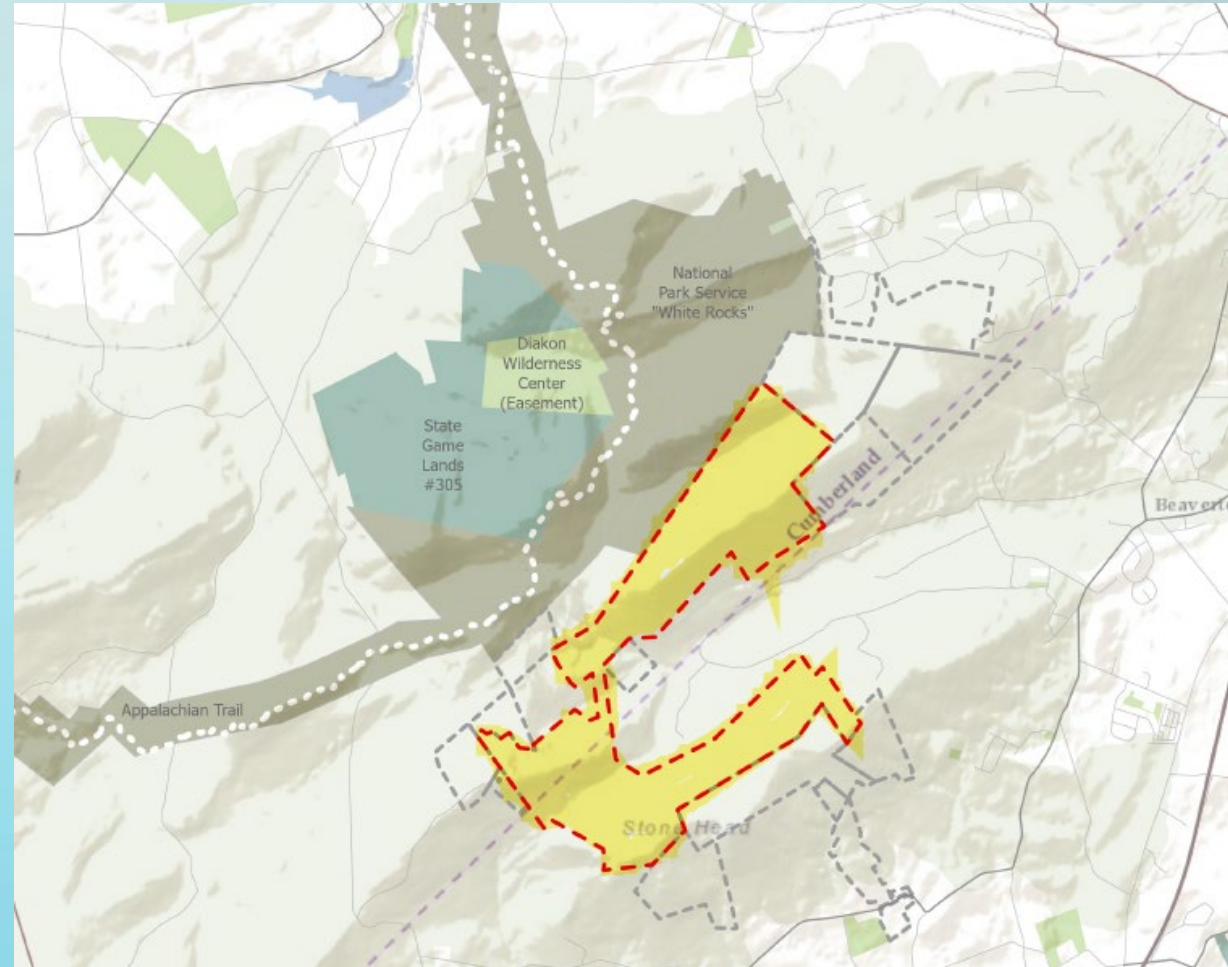
American Recovery Plan Grants

- Carlisle Borough - \$254,833 for construction of Fairground Ave linear park
- Cumberland Valley Rails to Trails Council - \$79,402 for the Orrstown Road Trail Extension
- Hampden Township - \$400,000 for swimming pool rehab
